5. Brief Description of Services Provided:
Crico performs three functions related to facilities maintenance at the Food and Drug Administration's Muirkirk Road Complex. Crico provides all personnel, equipment, materials, and supervision necessary to provide janitorial, grounds maintenance, and pest control services at the Muirkirk Road Complex (MRC) known as 8301 (Module I), 8401 (Module II, Building A and Outbuildings) and 8501 (BRF, including loading dock, Fitness Center, and OCI office) Muirkirk Road, Laurel, Maryland 20708. The Janitorial Services includes cleaning windows, floor maintenance, sweeping, dust mopping, damp mopping, carpet shampooing, entrance rungs, floor waxing, trash collection, dusting, spot cleaning, metal polishing, wood polishing, and carpet vacuuming. Within the buildings, employee will clean bathrooms, laboratories, offices, conference rooms, lunchroom, cafeteria, kitchen, health unit, lobbies, corridors, stairways, loading dock areas, elevators, drinking fountains, guard stations, shed, entrance, windows, and glass. The statement of work details the schedule for janitorial services. Daily, Crico's employees are responsible for collecting recyclable items. Project employees will collect wastepaper, plastic products, cans, and cardboard items from designated containers and locations, and bring materials to designated collection areas. Crico will power wash the exterior face of the buildings including brick walls, windows, roof skylights, siding, plastic and metal, door entrances and exits including sidewalks to main entrances. This will be done twice (one time at the Base Contract and one time at option year No. 3). Grounds Maintenance is performed daily on the Muirkirk Road Campus in identified outside public areas below and as directed by the COR: Pest Control services are provided as part of the required 80 man-hours per month of miscellaneous utility jobs as requested by the CO or COR. Crico provides all labor, equipment, tools, materials, supplies, supervision, and other items and services necessary to perform all services. Crico has an on-site supervisor and an alternate who are responsible for the conduct and competent performance of work. Crico has a total of 11 employees assigned to this project. All employees are experienced in the type of work involved and familiar with the specifications of this contract. All employees operating motor vehicles possess a valid state driver's license, and those employees operating larger vehicles have a commercial driver's license.
